Proceedings:

Prizes:

The Danish Animal Welfare Society will give young researchers awards to the best oral presentation and best poster consisting of 500 Eur each. The winners will be selected by the Scientific Committee.

The Danish Animal Welfare Society will give a poster award to the best poster presented by universities or NGO's contributing significantly to replace or reduce the number of laboratory animals used in animal experimentation or education related to cell toxicology. Specifically, original ideas and new methods with potential to create public awareness on the 3Rs; mainly replacement and reduction, will be favored. The results or methods presented should be based on a strong scientific background and be understandable to layman.

The award consists of financial support equivalent to 1000 euro to be used for reimbursement of expenses related to 3Rs activities (e.g., in support of research, dissemination activities or participation of the authors in relevant conferences or workshops).

The chairman of the committee for experimental animals as well as the responsible project manager from the Danish Animal Welfare Society will select the winning poster.
